
Add Nose Piece (Coffee Tin Tie Preferred)





Turn down the top ¾" to create channel for nose piece and seal in place (see next)

Fold to Create "Upward Pleat"



Heat Seal on Angle to Secure Pleats in Place (remove clips first)

Remove Clip and Seal




Turn Up Bottom ¾" and Clip in Place




Turn up the bottom ¾" and clip in place (orange clips in photo)

Turn Mask Over (Face Down)





(bringing the bottom edge up to the top edge)




Unclip Top Clips


(Helps prevent accidentally sealing it down)






Turn Down the Top ¾" and Clip in Place (pink clips in photo)








